

New American Cities, a career upskilling and economic empowerment program that connects refugees and immigrants to training, certification, and other services to support meaningful employment.



Welcome Center programming, which provides trauma-informed case management for asylum seekers including connection to legal services, mental health screening, education services, and emergency assistance.



Mental Health Services for uninsured immigrant children and families, as well as peer support groups for Afghan evacuees, victims of family separation, and more.



New American Community Lending, which financially empowers clients through the provision of individual, consumer, and microenterprise loans to promote stability, security, and a share in the American Dream.



Emergency Response, such as temporary housing, financial assistance, and transportation for recently arrived refugees.
